**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' UNCONTESTED MOTION FOR
APPROVAL OF ATTORNEYS' FEES, COSTS, EXPENSES, AND SERVICE AWARDS**

AND NOW, this 24th day of November, 2020, upon consideration of Plaintiff's uncontested Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs, Expenses, and Service Award (Docket No. 35) and all documents filed in connection therewith, after a hearing on November 19, 2020, and for the reasons stated on the record at that hearing, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Motion is **GRANTED** as set forth below.

Plaintiff Marie Abdelmessih brought this class action case against Defendant Five Below Inc. on April 8, 2019. (Class Action Complaint, Docket No. 1.) On November 29, 2019, Plaintiff and Defendant reached a settlement (the "Settlement"), which resolved all claims in the above-captioned action.

Plaintiff has now filed an unopposed Motion requesting that this Court award to Class Counsel \$93,750 in attorneys' fees, costs, and expenses; consisting of \$9,219.28 in costs and expenses, and \$84,530.72 in attorneys' fees. (Docket No. 35). Plaintiff also requests that the Court grant the Class Representative a service award of \$1,500. (Id.)

Having reviewed the motion and supporting memorandum of law, the Court finds that Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees is reasonable, that the award of \$9,219.28 for expenses

is reasonable, and that the service award in the amount of \$1,500 is reasonable. The Court therefore **APPROVES** Class Counsel's request for fees, costs, expenses, and the requested service award for the class representative.

For these reasons, the Court (i) **AWARDS** \$93,750 in attorneys' fees, costs, and expenses; consisting of \$9,219.28 in costs and expenses, and \$84,530.72 in attorneys' fees to Class Counsel, which Defendant has agreed to pay separately from the relief made available to the Class, and (ii) **GRANTS** a Service Award of \$1,500.00 to the Class Representative, which Defendant has agreed to pay separately from the relief made available to the Class.
